Your Prostate

Prostate problems are common, particularly in men aged over 50. Signs of a prostate problem include:

- · difficulty starting or stopping urinating
- a weak flow
- blood in the urine
- feeling like you're not able to fully empty your bladder
- · prolonged dribbling after you've finished peeing
- needing to pee more frequently or more suddenly
- · waking up during the night to pee

You should make an appointment with a doctor if you have any of these symptoms.

Pharmacy First

You can now go to the pharmacy for assessment and treatment (including prescription-only medicines such as antibitoics) for seven common conditions without a GP appointment:

- Urinary tract infection (water infection) in women aged 16-64 years
- Impetigo (skin infection) in those aged over 1 year
- Infected Insect bite in those aged over 1 year
- Sore throat in those aged 5 years and over
- Sinusitis in those aged 12 years and over
- Shingles in those 18 years and over
- Earache in children 1 -17 years

Cervical Cancer Screening

Cervical screening (also called a smear test), is a test to check the health of the cervix and help prevent cervical cancer. It's offered to women and people with a cervix aged 25 to 64. You will be automatically called up.

Finding pre-cancerous changed early means you can be monitored and treated to reduce the chance of developing cancer.
